ARRESTED FOR A MISDEMEANOR?

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR CITATION AND RELEASE OR OWN RECOGNIZANCE RELEASE.

THIS MEANS YOU CAN BE RELEASED AT NO COST.

BEFORE YOU PAY BAIL, SEE IF THIS APPLIES TO YOUR SITUATION!

CITATION AND RELEASE

YOU MUST BE:

- ✓ Sober, able to identity yourself, and willing to sign a promise to appear in court.
- ✓ Arrested for a misdemeanor or on misdemeanor warrants totaling less than \$5,000

YOU MUST NOT BE ACCUSED OF:

- ✓ Domestic violence or violating a restraining order
- ✓ An offense involving violence, firearms, or resisting arrest when you have been accused of an offense involving violence or firearms within the past 12 months
- ✓ The same offense for the 2nd time within 24 hours
- ✓ A violation of probation
- ✓ Driving on a suspended license under Vehicle Code 14601 when you have a conviction for the same offense within the past 5 years
- ✓ Driving under the influence when you have been accused of a DUI within the past 12 months or have been convicted of a DUI within the past 10 years

If you are eligible you will be released after the booking process and will not be required to pay bail.

OWN RECOGNIZANCE RELEASE

If you are in custody you may be eligible for O.R. release. This means that you will be released if a judge determines that you are not a safety risk and are likely to appear for your court date. The judge will only ask you to promise to appear for your court date; you will not be required to pay bail. The judge may take some time to make this determination and may consider the following: the crime you have been accused of, your criminal history, and if you have failed to appear at court in the past.
